

#### OTHER WAYS TO VOTE

#### Vote early (absentee)

In Minnesota, you can vote early with an absentee ballot starting 46 days before Election Day. You can **request an absentee ballot online**. Read about other options and more information about absentee voting at the links below.

#### Vote from military or abroad

Military and voters living abroad can use a special process to vote absentee.

#### Track your absentee ballot

Track the status of your ballot or confirm that it was received back and accepted without problem.

Some cities and towns can hold elections by mail instead of voting at polling places.

#### Go to online absentee application

To request an absentee ballot for the August primary and/or November general election, use the online absentee application, or one of downloadable applications below. Return your completed absentee application to your county election office by mail, fax or email.

Use this application for federal, state and county elections

To complete this application online you must:


- Be eligible to register and vote in Minnesota
- Provide an email address
- Provide your identification number: MN-issued driver's license, Minnesota ID card or last 4 digits of Social Security Number

If you do not have an email address <u>and</u> one of the identification numbers above, you cannot apply for your absentee ballot online. You may apply with a paper form by clicking this link, selecting your preferred language, and printing out the <u>paper absentee ballot application</u>.

If you are an active duty military or overseas voter, do not use this application. Use the <u>special application</u> for military and overseas voters.

If you already submitted your application, do not submit another one online; use the <u>Absentee Ballot</u>

<u>Lookup</u> to find out where your absentee ballot is in the process, or <u>contact your county election office</u>.

- For election security, the information you provided on your application will be verified. On average, this check takes 3 business days to complete.
- You will receive an email confirmation when verification is successfully completed. At that time, your application will be directed to election officials for processing.
- Once processed, you can check the status of your application and absentee ballot online.
- Remember which identification number you provided on your application (MN-issued driver's license, Minnesota ID card, or last 4 digits of Social Security Number). You will need to provide this number when you return your absentee ballot.
