A	Addition	1. Going to the movies makes me hungry, and I buy a lot of popcorn. 2.
N	Comparison/Contrast	1. He doesn't like pie, nor does he like ice cream. 2.
B	Comparison/Contrast	1. Yesterday was Saturday, but I went to school anyway. 2.
O	Choice/Option/Alternative	1. I can go to college in St. Paul, or I can go to college in Minneapolis. 2.
Y	Opposition/Contrast/Concession	1. Monday I did poorly on a test, yet I didn't give up hope. 2.
S	Result/Effect	1. Going on vacation costs a lot of money, so I'm starting to save now. 2.
