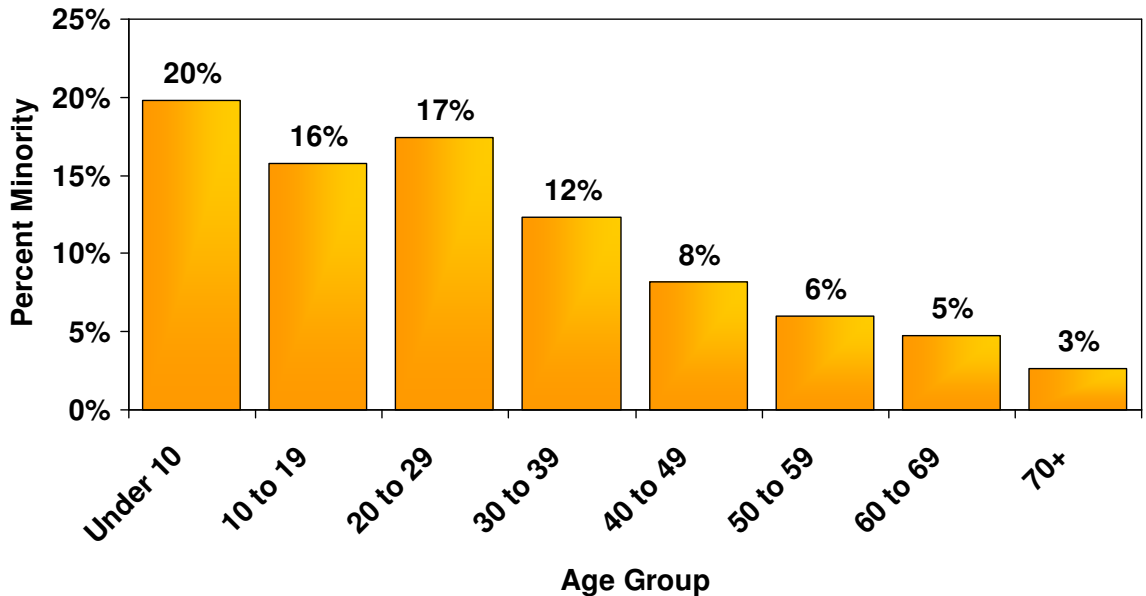


# Minnesota's Children Are More Diverse Than Older People
