

This is a 12-hour training for volunteers who will be teaching reading, writing, math or GED to native English speaking or advanced ESL students. The workshop is appropriate for volunteers who will be working with learners one-to-one, in small groups or classrooms.

You'll learn how to:

- Establish academic and real-life reading and writing goals with your students
- Use textbooks to meet your students' goals
- Teach alphabets, fluency, vocabulary and comprehension
- Help your students prepare for the GED tests
- Plan lessons that meet your students' needs
- Find the many teaching resources available to volunteer tutors

The 12-hour training is broken down into four sessions; each session is three hours long. Participants must complete all four sessions to receive a certificate of completion.

Participants are encouraged to attend all four sessions in order. But if you need to miss a session, you are welcome to make it up at a later date.
