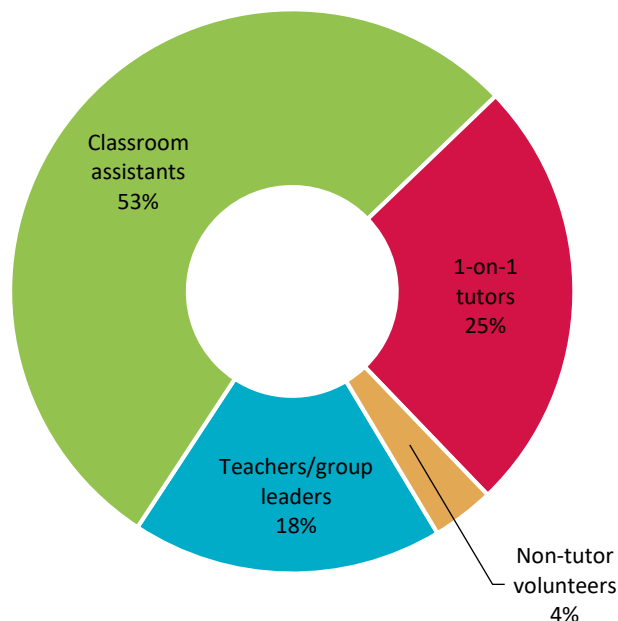

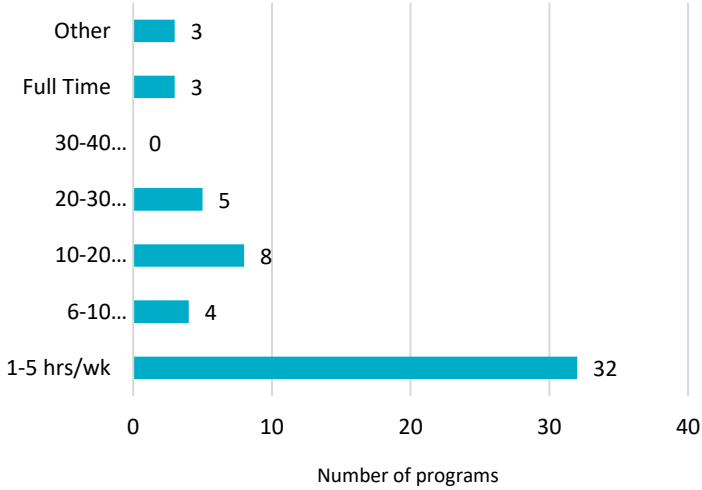

Non-tutor volunteers...	...at 2 of 63 programs

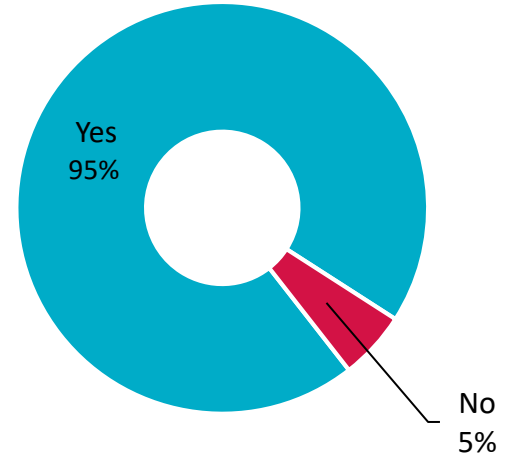


Adult Basic Education Staff Allocations

How many hours per week does your program allocate for adult literacy (ABE) volunteer coordination?

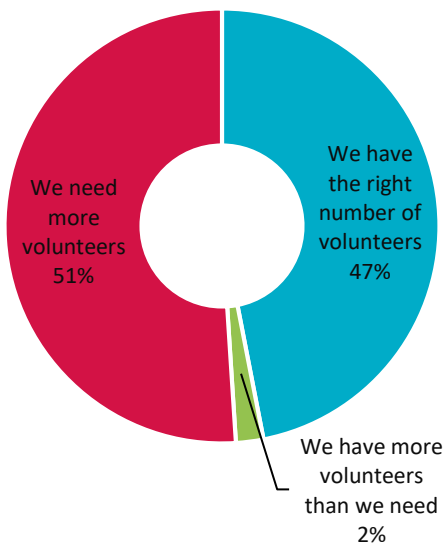


Does the volunteer coordinator also play another role in your program?

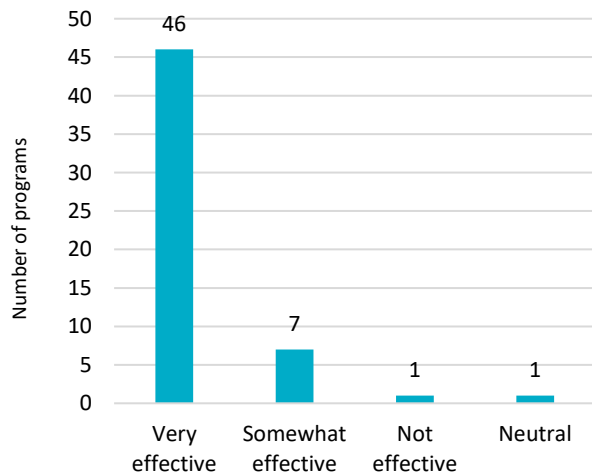


Volunteer Needs, Effectiveness and Benefits

How would you describe your program's volunteer needs?

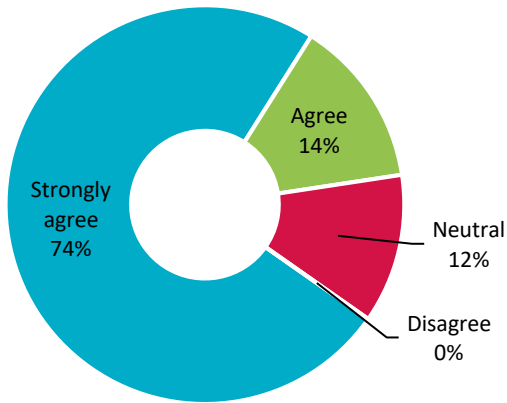


How effective are volunteers in helping your program provide quality services to your learners?

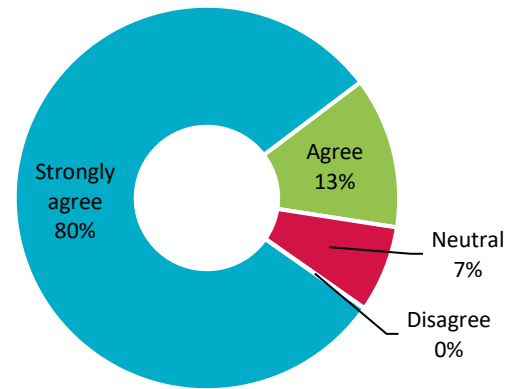

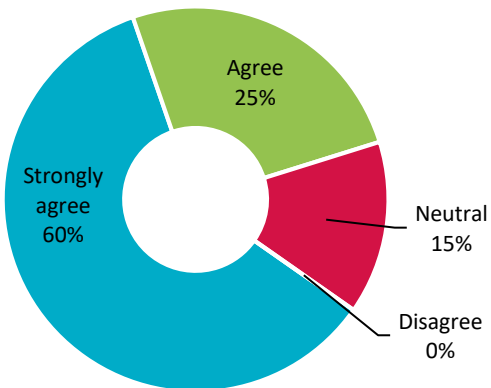
1. The literacy council provides valuable volunteer outreach services.



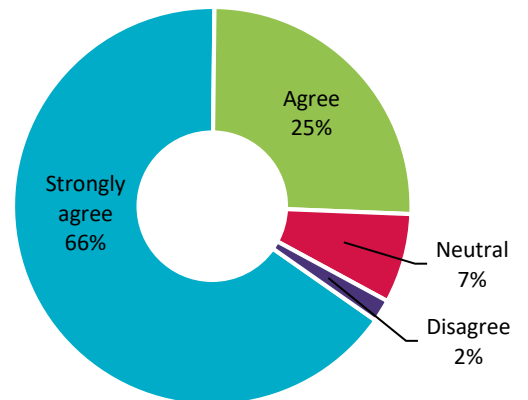
2. The literacy council provides valuable volunteer training services.



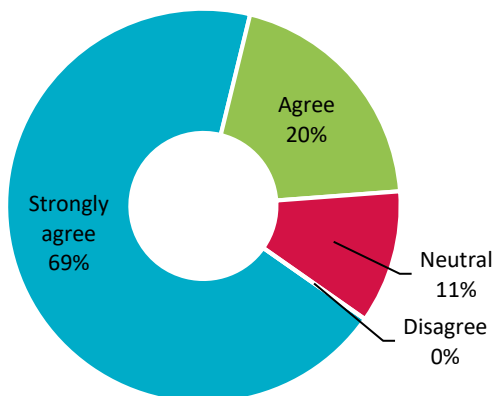
3. The literacy council provides valuable assistance, training and resources to help me manage my volunteer program.



4. The literacy council provides services that I would not be able to provide myself.

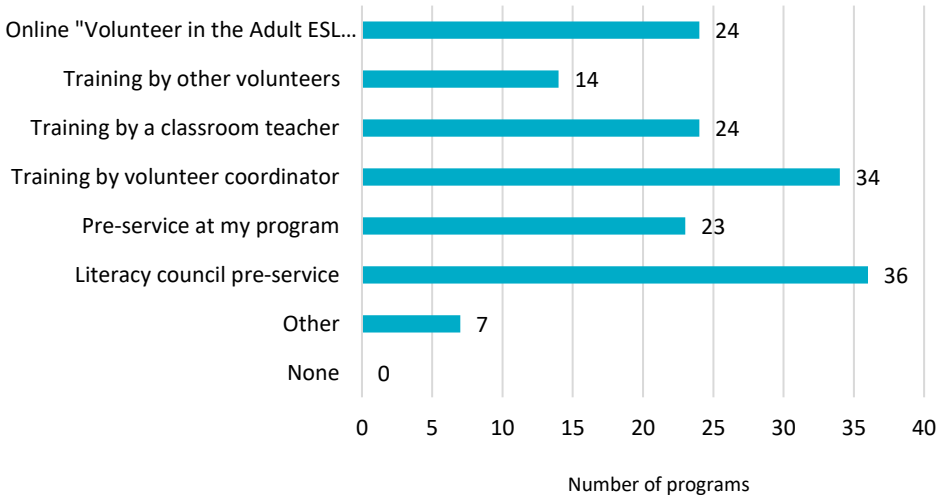


5. The literacy council helps to improve the quality of my volunteer program.

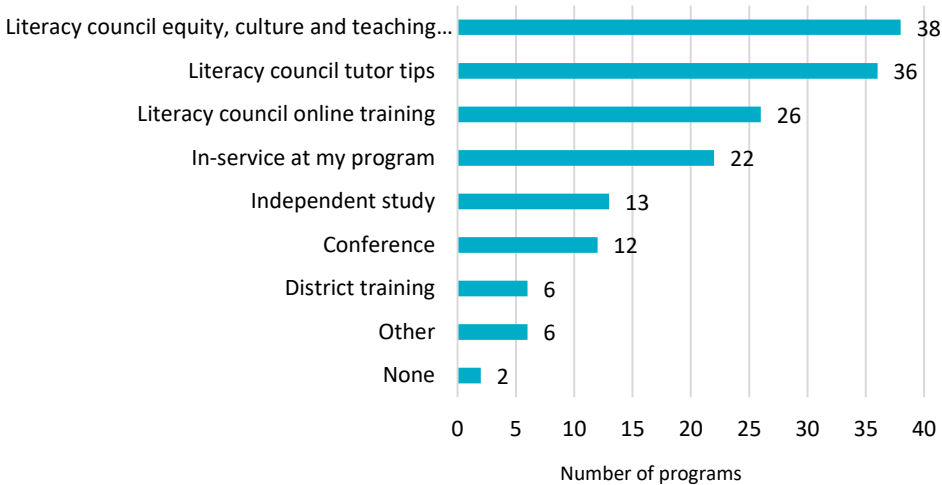


Use of Minnesota Literacy Council Trainings

What ongoing training do your volunteers receive?



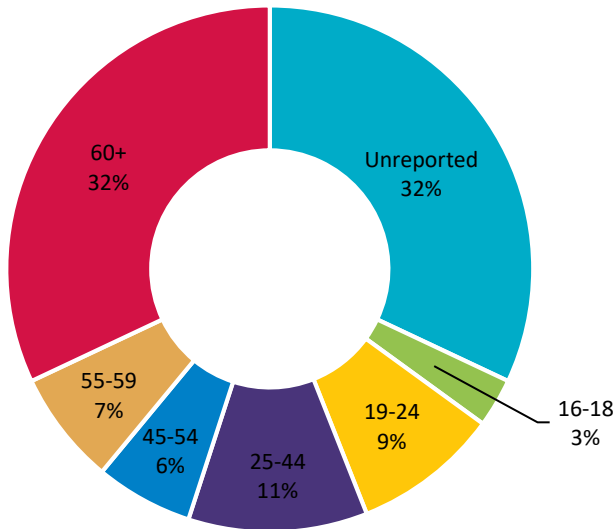
Projections for Volunteer Needs in 2019-2020

Approximately how many volunteers do you expect will complete an online training module next year?	540

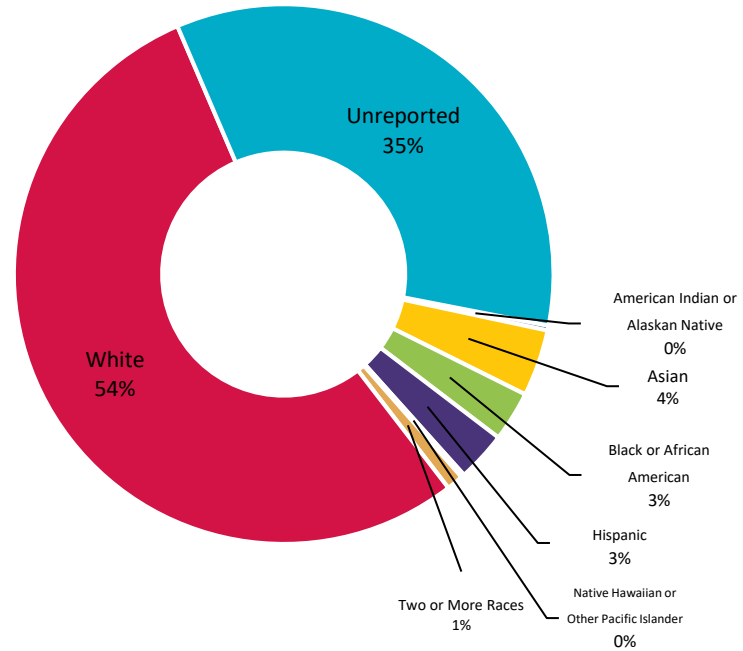
Volunteer Demographics

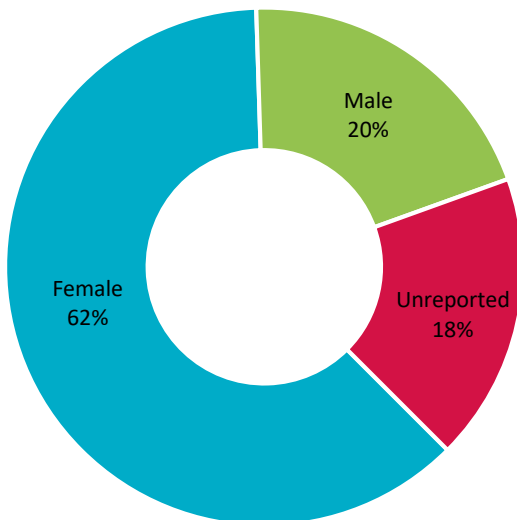
Age
