Eligibility:

Author or artist must be enrolled in an Adult Basic Education program in Minnesota. All submissions must be original material.

Only one submission per person will be considered. Submissions that are not selected for publication must be resubmitted to be considered for the next edition.

Literacy Minnesota reserves the right to edit and/or exclude submissions. Submissions not included in the book may be published on our website.

Submission length should be no more than 400 words.

Submission Requirements – Written Work:

Written works must be submitted via webform: <u>literacymn.org/journeys-2023</u>. Email or USPS submissions will not be accepted. Submit a separate webform for each student. Only one submission per student. As part of the *Journeys* book production process, edits may be made for comprehension, clarity and spelling.

Submission Requirements – Art Work:

Submit the original.

Include the **Journeys Artwork Submission Form** (next page), with all areas completed. Send art entries to the address on the Artwork Submission Form.
