- Outside employment: part time allowed with approval from supervisor and Literacy Minnesota (form required)
- Education: part time classes allowed with approval from supervisor and Literacy Minnesota (form required)
- Living allowance: \$513.94 biweekly (pre-tax)
- End of service: Education Award \$6,195; OR Cash Stipend \$1,803
- Teleservice reimbursement: \$25 per month (\$300 per year) (internet, phone, video conference subscription, equipment) (form & receipts required)
- CSA Produce shares: Free, farm fresh produce during summer and fall harvest seasons
- Professional development: \$150 towards professional development (form required)
- Training: Literacy Leadership monthly VISTA member training days are required
- Mileage/public transit for meetings/events required by Literacy Minnesota is reimbursed by Literacy Minnesota (form required)
- Mileage/public transit for meetings/events required by host site is reimbursed by host site (form required)
